Councillor's Community Grant 2026 will go live on 20th May 2026 with councillors expected to be able to allocate the application forms to not for profit groups and organisations before the end of that week. This year we will have £4192 of grant funding before the closing date of 28th February 2027. The addition of £192 is because the council agreed that last year's underspend could be rolled over, which has been reallocated equally to this year's allowance for the 55 councillors.
