<u>The seasonal beach ban period for dogs</u> under the Public Space Protection Order (PSPO) started on Thursday 10 May, and lasts until Tuesday 30 September, for beaches in the following places:

Central Mablethorpe - Central Sutton on Sea - Central Skegness

Dog friendly beaches include: Ingoldmells Beach (South Beach, all year), Saltfleetby Theddlethorpe Dunes, Chapel St Leonards Beach, Huttoft/Moggs eye, Winthorpe, Anderby creek / Wolla Bank, Trusthorpe and Sandilands beach
