10. TO RECEIVE REPORT FROM LINCOLNSHIRE ROAD SAFETY PARTNERSHIP REGARDING INTERACTIVE SPEED SIGN

- b. Following discussion it was resolved to use lighting column 5 on Station Road (40mph) and lighting column 9a on Spilsby Road (30mph) and to have a post in the area of the school (30mph) at a cost of £200.00. The new post will need to be on the school side of the road.
- c. It was resolved to have 4 x 30mph signs and 2 x 40mph signs.
- d. Following discussion it was proposed by Cllr Baker and seconded by Cllr Sweetman to order a DF11 Interactive Speed Sign at a cost of approximately £2300.00.
